*Who:* Current high school Seniors

*Who:* Current high school seniors

**ROTC Scholarships:**

*Who:* Students between the ages of 17-26

*Value:* Up to \$180,000 (covers cost of tuition, books, fees, uniforms, and includes a monthly stipend)

*Requirements:* U.S. citizen, be between the ages of 1-26, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, have a high school diploma, meet physical standards, and agree to accept a commission and serve in the military on active duty or in a reserve component after graduating

*Requirements:* Candidates for this award shall be daughters, step-daughters, sons, or step-sons, grandchildren, or step-grandchildren of veterans who served in the Armed Forces during the eligibility dates for membership in “The American Legion”; Applicants must be in their senior year of high school; and Applicant must complete 50 hours of volunteer service within the community, verified in writing by the recipient organization(s)

*Value:* One scholarship of each: \$2,500, \$2,000 and \$1,500

*Apply:* paper application is available in the Counseling Center

*Deadline:* Must be received on or before March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010

**“Mike Nash Memorial Scholarship Fund” Vietnam Veterans of America**

*Requirements:* be a Vietnam Veterans of America (VVA) member, a spouse, child, stepchild or grandchild of a VVA member; or a spouse, child, stepchild or grandchild of an MIA, KIA or deceased Vietnam Veteran; Registered to attend a minimum of half time an accredited educational/technical college or university or post-secondary institution
